1. Gallon sized paint...interior or exterior latex enamel. Colors most needed: RED, BLUE, YELLOW, (True, red, true blue, true yellow, ie. not mixed with white or black) WHITE and BLACK. We can mix the rest of the colors from these.

I think semi gloss would be best.

2. Primer. 5 gallon size.
3. Paint brushes...1/2" size to 3" sizes.
4. Rollers (just the sleeves) and plastic liners.
5. Drop cloths.
